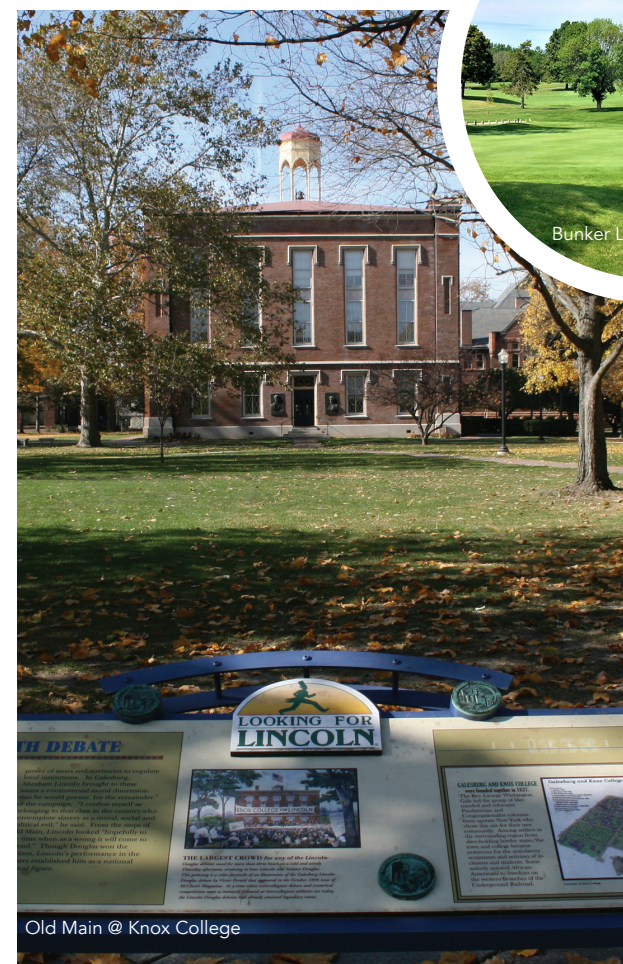

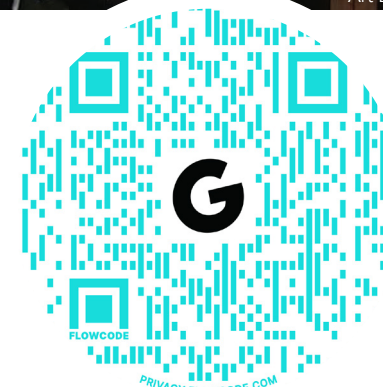
Knox-Galesburg Symphony

Prairie Players Civic Theatre has roots in the over 100 year history of community theatre in Galesburg. Listen to the Knox-Galesburg Symphony and enjoy the beautiful live music of various genres including anything from the classics to a whimsical children's concert.

The Orpheum Theatre, which opened in 1916, was originally built as a vaudeville house, and hosted many early starts of stage and screen, including Jack Benny, George Burns and Houdini.

While in the area, please be sure to take in some of the great local art throughout the city ranging from our unique artist designed and painted trash cans to eye-catching murals in our historic downtown.

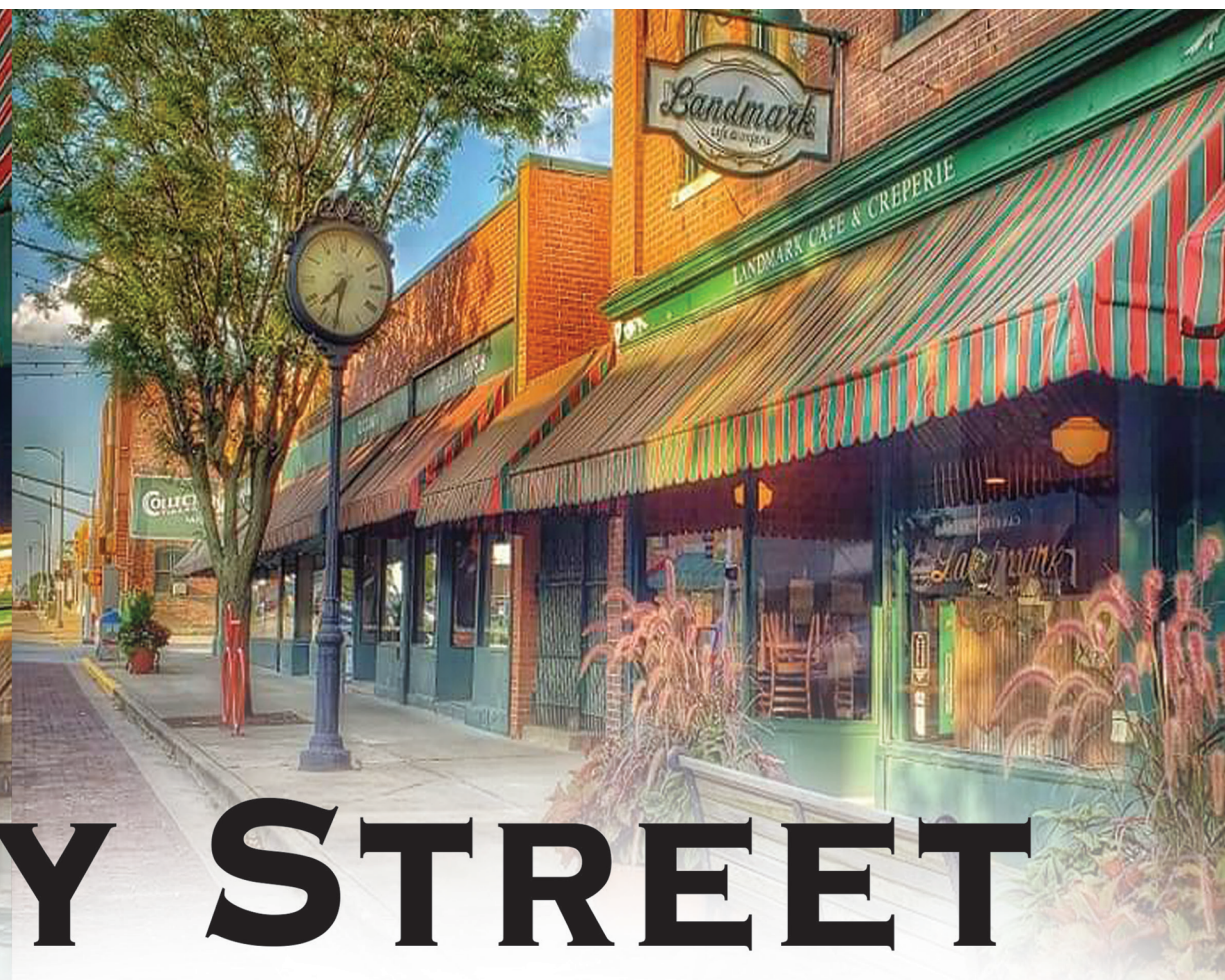

A small town with big time flavor, Galesburg will get you in the spirit!



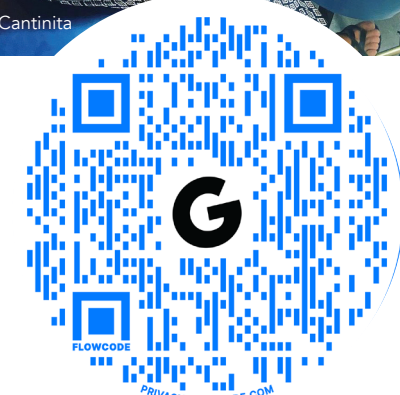
